


| TA & Hills Minister inaugurates 7th PNNM general conference

Senapati, Dec 12: TA & Hills Minister Vungzagin Valte on Sunday inaugurated the 7th General Conference of Poumai Naga Women's Union (PNNM) at Senapati in the presence of L Dikho, PHE Minister.
