

# 5 ST students clear JEE, all set to join NIT-Tiruchy

TIRUCHY, JULY 9:

Five students, four of them scheduled tribe girl students of Tiruchy district, have successfully completed the national-level JEE examination this year. They registered their names at the National Institute of Technology - Tiruchirappalli (NIT-T) to join the five-year B.E. course.

Official sources said in the last 60 years, for the first time, these tribal students are going to join a Central government engineering education institution like NIT-T.

Kavini, a tribal student of Kailasapuram, secured the 302nd rank in Tamil Nadu in the recent JEE examination, and will join the 5-year architecture course.

Another tribal student, Rohini, from Thuraiyur,

who secured the 6,910th rank, Rithiga from Mutharasanallur village (2,538th rank), Divya Preetha from Poolangudi village (7,106th rank) and tribal boy Danush Rajkumar of Kailashapuram (8,872nd rank) are joining NIT-T to pursue chemical engineering, computer science, production engineering courses respectively, the sources added.
